2020 VRCA Hockey Playoff Pool – Rules, Terms & Conditions

a. The Game

The 2020 VRCA Hockey Playoff Pool ("Contest") is an on-line game designed to test one's own skills when it comes to predicting the performance of various hockey players from various teams. Winners will be determined based on their ability to use their skill and knowledge of hockey teams, players and related rules to accumulate the most Pool Points in accordance with the Scoring System as described below and these Official Rules. The box pool player draft will be based on the result of the National Hockey League (NHL) 2020 Playoffs taking place August 11, 2020 – October 4, 2020. At the end of the 2020 NHL playoffs, entries will be ranked based upon the total number of points accumulated following information posted on NHL.com. One entry includes 21 selections (15 Forwards, 3 Defence and 3 Goalies).

b. Eligibility

The Contest is open only to people who have reached the age of 19. The 2020 VRCA Hockey Playoff Pool will be open only to employees of VRCA members (excluding Quebec) or legal residents of British Columbia with the exception of the following; members of the VRCA Board of Directors and VRCA staff. If you are ineligible for the contest, you may play the game and have your place noted in the standings; however you will not be eligible to win a prize.

c. Contest Period

Ticket sales commence on Thursday, July 30, 2020 at 9:00am PDT and end on Monday, August 10, 2020 at 11:59pm PDT. The 2020 VRCA Hockey Playoff Pool "Contest" is anticipated to run between Tuesday, August 11, 2020 and Sunday, October 4, 2020. All contest winners will be notified by no later than Friday, October 9, 2020.

d. How to Enter

To enter the 2020 VRCA Hockey Playoff Pool you must register on the VRCA website at <https://my.vrca.ca/page/events>. Online registration is open between Thursday, July 30, 2020 at 9:00am PDT and Monday, August 10, 2020 at 11:59pm PDT. Upon registering you will receive a link to access the pool on <https://hockeydraft.ca/> where you will enter a first and last name, email and password. Please make note of this information as you will require it to log in and make any changes to your pool draft prior to the entry deadline date on Friday, August 14, 2020 at 11:59pm PDT.

e. How to Play

The objective of the 2020 VRCA Hockey Playoff Pool is to accumulate the highest number of Pool Points based on the Scoring System (see below breakdown). Each team you select will consist of 1 player from each of the boxes. *If a player is injured, he cannot be swapped out.

f. Scoring System

All Forwards: 1 Goal = 1 Pool Point. 1 Assist = 1 Pool Point. 1 Game Winning Goal = +1 Pool Point (2 total including the goal point).

All Defense: 1 Goal = 1 Pool Point. 1 Assist = 1 Pool Point. 1 Game Winning Goal = +1 Pool Point (2 total including the goal point).

All Goalies: 1 Win = 1 Pool Point. 1 Shutout = +2 Pool Points (3 total including a win). 1 Goal = 1 Pool Point. 1 Assist = 1 Pool Point. 1 Game Winning Goal = 1 Pool Point (2 total including the goal point).

g. Standings and Updates

Contest standings are updated daily on the web site at 2:30am PDT. The website will include player and entrant point totals.

h. Winners and Prizes

The entrant with the most Pool Points accumulated during the 2020 NHL Playoffs will win 50% of the gross ticket sales with the other 50% being donated to select charities. The following is the official breakdown of prizes:

i. Odds

Odds of winning depend on number of entrants in the Pool.

j. Ties

The 2020 VRCA Hockey Playoff Pool is not a draft. Therefore, there is a possibility that two entrants may end up with the same player selections. In addition, two different rosters may add up to the same total points. In case of a tie the following rules will apply:

Between the pool teams that are tied, the pool team with the most goals will prevail. If it is still tied, the pool team with the most goalie shutouts will prevail. If it is still tied, the pool team with the most regulation time goals will prevail. In the event that the pool teams remain tied, the winner will be determined by a coin toss.
