RE: ETRO Construction COVID-19 (coronavirus) Response & Policy

Like many of you, we have been closely following the developments surrounding coronavirus – both locally and abroad. At ETRO, we care deeply about our project partners and every individual that works or spends time on our project sites. ETRO is following recommendations made by the Government and its health officials to develop the following policies that go into affect immediately across all ETRO project sites and its head office:

Zero Tolerance Coronavirus Sickness Policy

- If you have cold or flu-like symptoms, you are not to enter any of ETRO's project sites or its head office
- You are to self-quarantine yourself for 14 calendar days
- If ETRO or another worker on site identifies an individual as having symptoms, they will be asked to leave site immediately and not return for a period of 14 calendar days while they are under self-quarantine

Travel

- If you are returning from a trip outside of Canada, you must stay home from work for a period of 14 days upon returning to British Columbia
- During this 14-day period, you are not to enter any of ETRO's project sites or head office
- If others within your household are returning from a trip outside of Canada (even if you are not), the above similarly applies

Personal Care

- Hand wash stations with running water, or nearby washrooms in existing/completed facilities have been setup to promote good hygiene and it is recommended that you wash your hands often with soap and water
- Avoid touching your face
- Cough or sneeze into your sleeve or into a tissue and throw it in the trash afterwards
- ETRO has also made arrangements for increased cleaning and sanitization of its site trailers and head office.

If you have been informed by your medical professional that you may be a carrier of the coronavirus, please inform ETRO's Site Supervisor.

Our goal is to promote your health and safety during this unprecedented time and will continue to follow the direction of the Government and health officials. ETRO will continue to monitor the ever-changing situation locally and abroad and will provide further updates and protocols as necessary.

Get vaccinated

Influenza or “flu” can cause serious illness. Vaccination is the best way to protect yourself and your family.



Cover your cough or sneeze
