## Health Monitoring for COVID-19

Health monitoring is a process of verifying that workers and visitors are fit for duty. Workers and visitors who are exhibiting symptoms of COVID 19 or are otherwise recommended to be in self-isolation or self-quarantine by the Public Health Authority are not permitted on Leducor projects.

The symptoms of COVID-19 are similar to other respiratory illnesses including the flu and the common cold and can develop between 2 and 14 days of exposure. They include:

- Fever
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing

**To protect workers and visitors and provide a safe and healthy workplace there is an increased responsibility on workers to monitor their health for symptoms and supervisors to verify that workers are fit for duty.**

Initially, each worker or visitor any workers or visitors intending to access the site must complete a Leducor Health Questionnaire. The purpose of the questionnaire is to verify that workers are free, to the best of their knowledge, of COVID-19 symptoms and related restrictions in accordance with Public Health Authority recommendations.

1. Supervisors must provide, each day, an attendance list of workers by name and phone contact – electronically. In the event that there is a COVID issue later this information will be especially helpful in identifying potential exposures and notifying them.
2. Supervisors are required to verify, **at start of shift**, that their workers are reporting healthy, fit for duty and to the best of their knowledge, free of any symptoms or restrictions associated with COVID-19 in accordance with the Leducor Health Questionnaire and recommendations of the Public Health Authority.
3. Supervisors provide notification **at start of shift** that workers are fit for duty to Leducor COVID-19 Safety Coordinator (CSC).
4. There is a potential for symptoms to develop over the course of the workday. Supervisors are required to verify, **at end of shift**, that their workers are still reporting healthy and to the best of their knowledge, free of any symptoms or restrictions associated with COVID-19 in accordance with the Health Questionnaire and recommendations of the Public Health Authority.
5. Supervisors provide an update on their workers' health **at end of shift** to Leducor CSC. If there are any significant changes to a worker's health notify Project Manager, Superintendent and HSE Manager / Lead.
